

Star of the week is all about celebrating students' achievements and supporting them. At EYFS we tend to encourage our young learners to grow and develop constantly in a creative and happy environment.






Pet Day

Students discovered new interests as they were exposed to a specially designed 'grown-up' experience.




































Odd Socks for Anti-bullying day 2022
