SIPS ASSESSMENT PATTERN

A Comprehensive Approach: How SIPS Tracks Student Attainment and Progress

At SIPS, we believe in a holistic and data-rich approach to understanding and maximizing student achievement. We employ a diverse range of assessment methods—from continuous internal checks to rigorous external examinations—to accurately track attainment and progress across all year groups. This multi-layered strategy ensures that no student's potential goes unnoticed and that teaching is precisely tailored to individual needs.

Internal Assessments: Guiding Daily Learning:

Our internal assessment structure provides continuous feedback to both students and teachers:

- 1. Formative Assessments: These ongoing checks—including quizzes, class participation, and immediate feedback on tasks—are integral to the learning process.
- 2. Summative Assessments: These internal exams, typically administered at the end of a unit or term, evaluate overall student learning and mastery of the curriculum content.

<u>International and External Exams:</u>

- 1.CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test Fourth Edition): This test assesses underlying academic potential across verbal, quantitative, non-verbal, and spatial reasoning. It is crucial for identifying hidden strengths and setting realistic academic targets.
- 2. **GL Progress Tests (English, Maths, and Science):** These standardized assessments measure attainment and progress in core subjects, offering robust data that helps teachers spot specific learning gaps and areas of strength.
- 3. IBT (International Benchmark Test) & TALA (The Test of Arabic Language Arts): These exams provide further external validation of our students' proficiency in key academic areas, benchmarking their performance internationally.

Board Exams

Our examination structure is aligned with internationally recognised standards and national requirements: IGCSE, AS, and A Level Qualifications: SIPS provides a pathway for students to achieve these prestigious international qualifications, which are essential for university entrance worldwide. These exams serve as the ultimate summative measure of subject mastery and critical thinking skills.

M<u>inistry of Education (MoE) Exams:</u> For students following the Ministry of Education section of our curriculum, we administer and prepare students for the mandatory Ministry of Education exams, ensuring full compliance with national academic standards and certification requirements.

SIPS maintains a comprehensive system for tracking student attainment, ensuring that every student is supported, challenged, and guided effectively towards academic success.











Our Ambassadors National Program

CAT4 ASSESSMENTS

The Cognitive Abilities Test Fourth Edition (CAT4) has successfully served as a vital diagnostic tool for students from Years 3 to 10. Its primary purpose is to move beyond subject-specific knowledge and assess the core cognitive abilities that underpin all learning: Verbal, Quantitative, Non-Verbal, and Spatial Reasoning.













CAT4 Information Coffee Morning: A Resounding Success

Our recent Parent Coffee Morning, held to discuss the Cognitive Abilities Test Fourth Edition (CAT4) results for students in Years 3 to 10, was a huge success. We were delighted by the strong turnout and the engaging discussions between parents and school staff. The session successfully demystified the CAT4 assessment, explaining how the data provides a complete profile of a child's Verbal, Quantitative, Non-Verbal, and Spatial Reasoning abilities. Parents gained a clear understanding of the key scores and, most importantly, how these profiles translate into targeted











يوم القلب العالمي 29 سبتمبر
















المعلم الصغير:






مهارات البحث والاستقصاء العلمي:
