
# FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK










## TRIP TO FUN POINT & SHARJAH AQUARIUM

Observing the rich marine biodiversity of the Gulf's waters allowed students to move beyond textbooks to classify different sea creatures—like fish, mollusks, and crustaceans—and study their unique adaptations to specific habitats, such as coral reefs and rock pools. This direct observation brought their Science topic on 'Animals, Including Humans' to life by offering real-world examples of structural adaptations and food chains.







The visit highlighted the importance of conservation, teaching the children about significant threats like pollution and overfishing. By making the marine geography tangible, the trip successfully connected abstract concepts to a local context, deepening their understanding of environmental responsibility and the vital need to protect natural resources.





# Trip to Sharjah Museum-Year 5 & 6

The visit of Year 5 and 6 students to the Sharjah Museum of Islamic Civilization was a stimulating cultural journey designed to broaden their historical and scientific understanding of the Islamic world.

Key learning outcomes included appreciating the artistic mastery through intricate calligraphy, ceramics, and metalwork in the Islamic Art Galleries, which covered various periods and empires.













Crucially, they learned about the immense contributions of Islamic scholars in the Ibn Al-Haytham Gallery of Science and Technology, seeing models and displays of discoveries in fields like astronomy, medicine, mathematics, and engineering, providing a tangible link to their curriculum topics on human achievement and scientific innovation.

This immersive experience fostered a sense of cultural pride and gave the students a deeper, contextual appreciation for the historical influence of Islamic civilization on the modern world.


Throughout the week, students engaged in a variety of classroom activities designed to develop logical thinking, problem-solving, and teamwork skills.




Why I love SIPS....







### **Celebrating UAE Coders Day at Sharjah International Private School**












# أسبوع الرياضيات- أولمبياد وتكريم



# أسبوع الرياضيات- توأمة













